It's the Gay Games 9 medal ... unveiled digitally today!

All registrants for the 2014 Gay Games presented by the Cleveland Foundationwill receive the unique beautifully designed, well-crafted 3-inch participant medal to wear around their necks.

First, second and third-place finishers in the various divisions and categories of the 35+ sports happening 9-16 August will take home gold, silver and bronze versions.



Graphic designer Jamey Christoph created the winning entry with his depiction combining memorable attributes of both Cleveland and Akron.

The front portrays Cleveland's iconic skyscrapers, including the Terminal Tower, lift bridge and smokestacks. The medal incorporates Akron's viaduct bridge and blimp on the front, while tire treads circle the back (Akron is a giant in the tire industry.)

Jamey was honored at a reception this fall with the Federation of Gay Games.
And Gay Games participants will be honored to wear one of the medals he designed.



Register for your event(s) before fees increase 8 January

Make sure to register soon for the sport or cultural event(s) in which you plan to participate during the 2014 Gay Games presented by the Cleveland Foundation.

Event-specific fees increase 8 January 2014. For a complete list of event fees, visit the <u>registration page</u>.

Events with current fees between \$50 and \$100 will be \$10 more and with current fees between \$101 and \$150 will be \$20 more beginning 8 January 2014. Sailing and golf will have additional fee increases.

NOTE: Participants must complete general registration before or at the same time they register for their event(s).
