About the Gay Games

Conceived by Olympian Tom Waddell in 1982, the Games bring together a global community every four years in friendship to experience participation, to elevate consciousness and self-esteem, and to achieve a form of cultural and intellectual collaboration. The Games are open to all adults regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity or athletic ability.

Perks of Registration

General registration includes:

- Access to exclusive Opening Ceremony parade party at Progressive Field
- March into Quicken Loans Arena representing CLE+AKR and experience Opening Ceremony from premium participant seating
- Participate in Closing Ceremony
- Receive the uniquely crafted participant medal (it's made of real metal)
- Enjoy unlimited public and Gay Games-provided transportation
- Take home the Official 2014 Gay Games commemorative program

The Games hosts 35+ sports as well as Band and Chorus events. Most sports offer divisions based on skill level. Others have age divisions. All adults are welcome.

General registrants are NOT required to participate in a sport or culture event.

Scholarship Opportunities

Through a collaboration with CANAPI, The LGBT Center of Greater Cleveland and the 2014 Gay Games presented by the Cleveland Foundation, additional funding has been awarded from The George Gund Foundation and The MetroHealth System.

This scholarship funding will allow the 2014 Gay Games to be the most diverse Games in history by awarding registrations to underrepresented populations.

Priority will be given to those who meet the following criteria: ability to pay, race/ethnicity, age, women and transgender or gender non-conforming individuals.

Successful first round applicants will be notified starting June 23, 2014. Applicants not selected will have the ability to purchase registration without late penalty. In most cases, scholarships are limited to the cost of the general registration fee (\$225 value). Per the scholarship funders, this opportunity is limited to Ohio residents only with preference given to northeast Ohio residents.
