5K & 10K Road Races FAQ

When?

Games Week: 9-16 August 2014

Road Races: 10K Monday, 11 August 2014, starts at 6 p.m.;
5K Thursday, 14 August 2014, time TBD.

Where?

The 10K Road Race will happen in park systems between Cleveland and Akron along the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad.

The 5K Road Race will happen at the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo.

What about transportation?

Participants have access to GG9-provided transportation, including public transport, and private shuttles from central Cleveland location to the race courses. Shuttle service also will be available between central locations in Cleveland and Akron.

How will the races be run?

Participants in the 5K and 10K will be provided with a bib which will contain a timing chip. Medals will be awarded to the top woman and man in each age group for the 5K and 10K.

Special Note: If you plan to participate in the Marathon/Half Marathon and the 5K and/or 10K, please register for the Marathon/Half Marathon ONLY.

What are the rules?

Participants may compete only in one age division.

How do I register?

General registration is \$195 per participant before 31 May 2014.

Upon completion, each participant can register for a specific sport. The fee for road races is \$60 before 15 January 2014 and increases to \$70 on 15 January.
